Applications

This counts UK domiciled students who made a reservation for a module linked to an Undergraduate HE level course starting in 2018/19.

Offers

As most OU UG courses are open entry there is no concept of an offer stage. For these courses Offers = Applications.

For courses such as Apprenticeships, Nursing and Social Work where there is a formal offer process we counted only those students who received a formal offer.

Accepted Offers

This counted all applications where students have gone on to register for study, i.e. accepted the terms and conditions for study and have paid their study fee or have indicated that they intend to pay using a student loan or other approved payment method.

Registrations

This was effectively a count of UG UK domiciled students registered at the first fee liability point on courses starting in 2018/19 (who will be returned to HESA on our 2018/19 HESA Student Record)
