Title:

'Is Life on Earth Unique?'

Content:

Discussing the question 'Is life on Earth unique?' are Professor George Porter, F.R.S., of the Royal Institution, Professor Peter Sylvester Bradley, and Professor Jack Meadows, both of the University of Leicester. The main discussion concerns the nature of the energy which synthesised the organic compounds and the nature of the Earth's primitive atmosphere.
