



## **The Open University Accessibility Statement for the Belfast office**

The Open University's Belfast office is fully accessible.

Due to the fact that the office is housed in a listed building, we are unfortunately unable to make alterations to the original front door on Victoria Street, which includes the front steps, or to the main reception desk.

However, our May Street entrance is fully accessible with a wide automatic door leading to a wheelchair ramp and same level access into the reception area and student hub.
