Doors will open approximately 45 minutes before the official ceremony start time. A musical programme from musicians from Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra will feature prior to the ceremony. Please make sure you and your guests have taken your seats no later than 15 minutes before the ceremony.




REFRESHMENTS
