## Army attacks Renamo base

The Mozambican army attacked a Renamo military base Saturday morning, 6 July. The attack was first reported by Renamo and Lusa yesterday, and confirmed by the government today.

Radio Moçambique said the attack took place at Matchele, 8 km from Muxungue, on a camp of about 50 huts. The base was set up by the same groups which attacked the main road, EN1, near Muxungue, Sofala, on 21 June, according to AIM, which cites Sofala provincial police commander Joaquim Nido.

Nido told RM there were no deaths or injuries. Macua Blogs and @Verdade claim injured on both sides.

Nido said the Renamo soldiers fled and none were captured.
