





PRESAGE: inputs into the teaching and learning process (e.g. learners, instructors, platform, provider institution, etc) PROCESS: pedagogy, design, resources, activities PRODUCT: outcomes for learners, completion rates,

The European MOOC Consortium (EMC) launches a Common Microcredential Framework (CMF) to create portable credentials for lifelong learners

BRUSSELS, 30 APRIL 2019: At the EADTU-EU Summit 2019, Brussels, the EMC launched a Common Microcredential Framework (CMF) with its founding platform partners including FutureLearn, France Université Numérique (FUN), OpenupEd, Miríadax, and EduOpen.

The move comes in response to demand from learners to develop new knowledge, skills and competencies from shorter, recognised and quality-assured courses, which can also be used to earn traditional university qualifications. The CMF establishes a framework for these goals to be achieved across Europe's leading MOOC platforms and the universities within their networks. The ambition is to lay the foundations for a new international credential for
