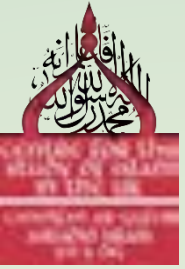

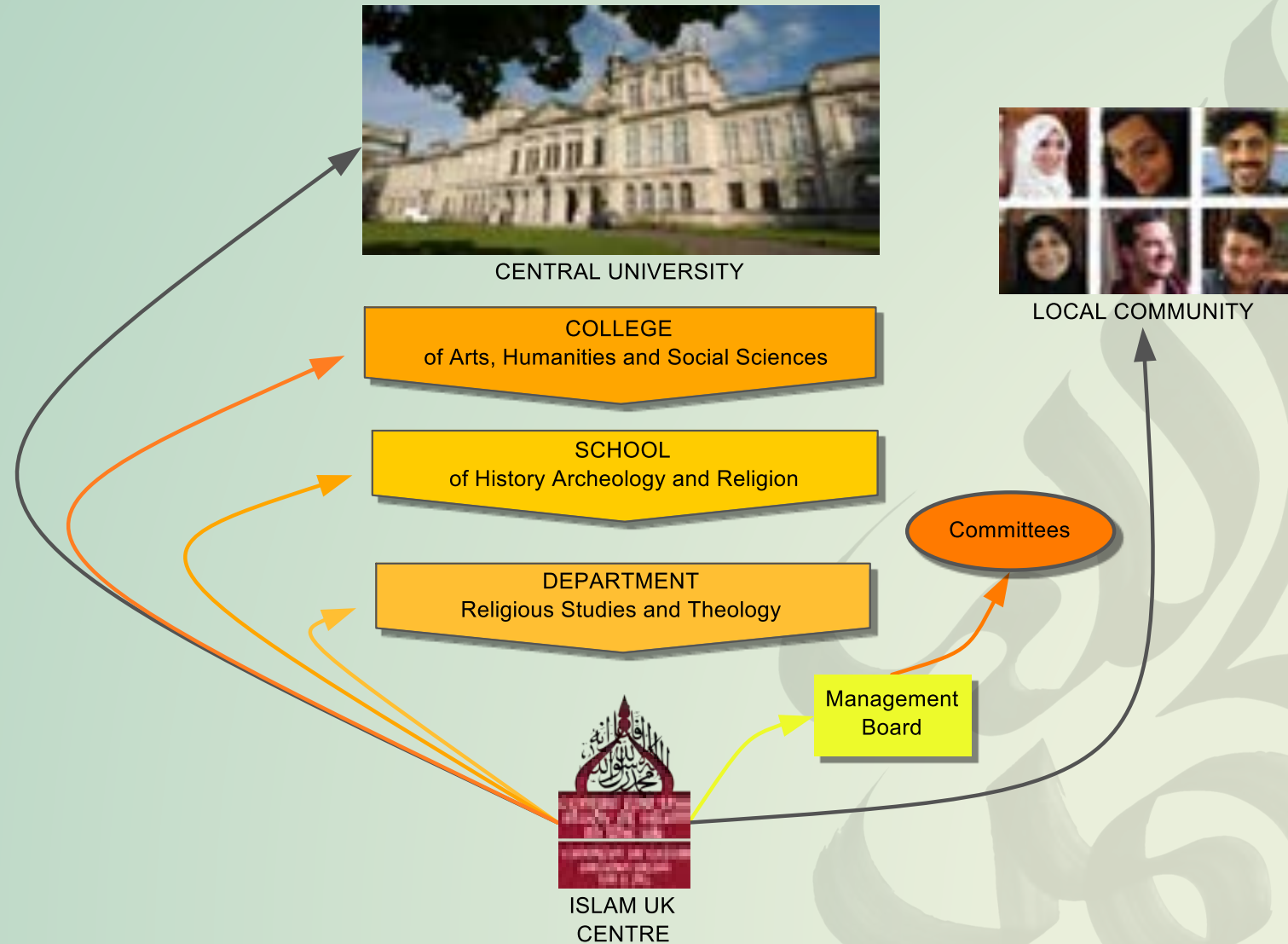
Launched in 2005

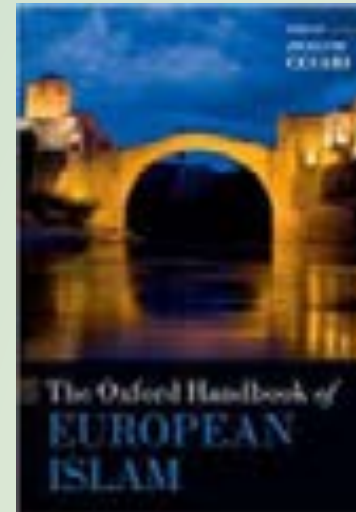

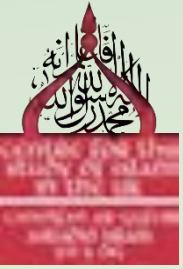
Islam UK Centre - Future research priorities and agendas

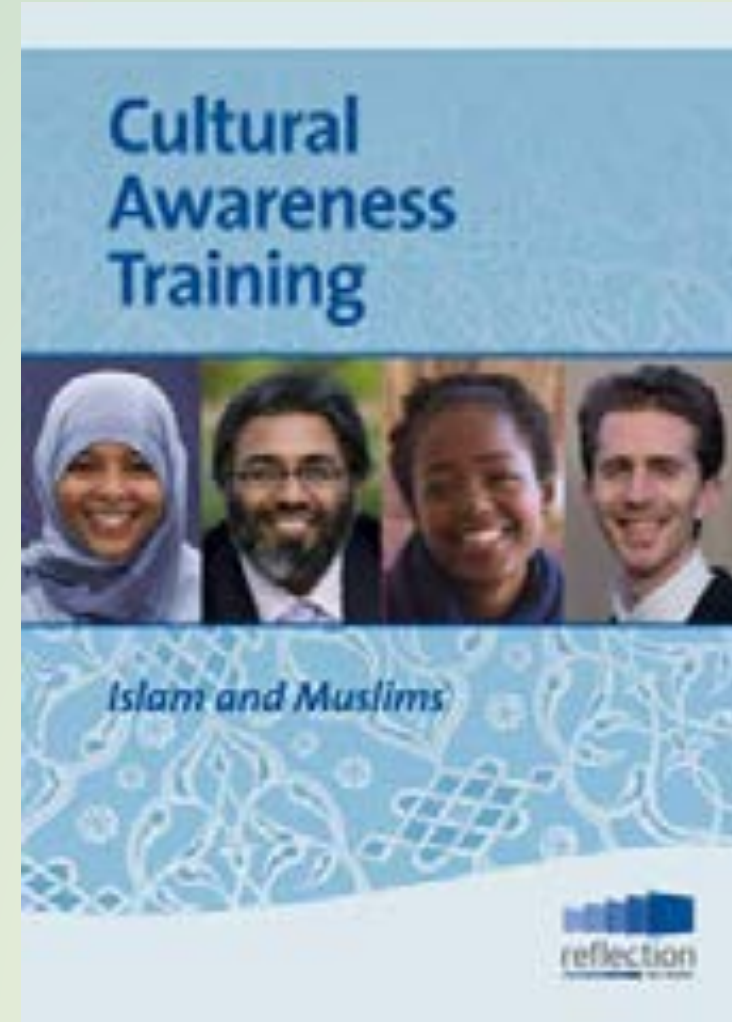
