


First Phase Science:

Observations are independent of the observer






First Phase Science: Objective Observations




Assumed that the construction of high quality observations can be *fully separated* from the actions that are to be improved by the use of these observations (e.g., landing a man on the moon)


Second Phase Science: Subjective Observations (The observer influences observations)



The Failure of the Club of Rome: The triumph of technocracy over democracy (anthopocentrism)










THE ANCIENT ATHENIAN AGORA






Demoscopio: The contemporary Athenian Agora

Because of the complexity of the Global Problematique of the Club of Rome we need AN ANTROPOCENTRIC PARADIGM and the science to support it.

Third Phase Science is the SCIENCE OF THE PEOPLE: <u>ANTROPOCENTIC</u>

- Assumes that the construction of high quality observations <u>fully includes</u> the <u>actions</u> that are to be improved.
 - Recognizes the validity of the interdependence among all the stakeholders in a social system.
- Enhances the quality of group observations. Its focus is on <u>"inter-subjectivity."</u>
 - Promotes the discovery of NEW DATA.



"The science of dialogic design is truly an <u>ANTROPOCENTRIC</u> science that enables stakeholders from all walks of life to become 'systems thinkers.' This is the sole rationale for its invention and evolution."


