Module description

This is an optional module in our Postgraduate Certificate of Education (Chartered Teacher). It is only available to Scottish teachers who have successfully completed the compulsory module EE851 *Self-evaluation* or taken an equivalent module at another institution. This module will allow participants the opportunity to gain an overview of their teaching and to encounter perspectives on learning and teaching as well as facilitate reflection and enquiry into classroom practice. It will emphasise:

- the pupil's perspective on teaching, learning and assessment
- social and cultural contexts of teaching
- that teaching and learning cannot be viewed in isolation
- the need for an alignment of teaching, learning and assessment
- the need for the presentation of substantial evidence of good practice.

Person specification

- familiarity with the Standard for Chartered Teacher.
