*Module description*

This is an optional module in our Postgraduate Certificate of Education (Chartered Teacher). It is only available to Scottish teachers who have successfully completed EE851 *Self-evaluation* or taken an equivalent module at another institution. The module provides students with an opportunity to further develop and demonstrate their commitment to building positive relationships and working as a member of a team. They will examine some definitions of collaboration and explore various existing and possible roles for themselves and others and the personal attributes and skills associated with different roles. It also looks at barriers to change and identifies practical steps to improve aspects of their work with others.
