<u>Literacy and Numeracy Skills Qualifications – Guide for prospective nursing students in</u> Scotland

To undertake the nursing degree programme, prospective candidates must have a certain level of literacyand numeracy as set out by the Nursing and Midwifery Council. **Candidates** must have evidence at the time of application so any study undertaken to achieve this must be completed by March 2025. These are the equivalent to SCQF Level 5.

The **Scottish** qualifications that evidence these are English and Maths at any of the following:

Intermediate 2 Standard Grade (Credit Level) National 5 O Grade (A or B)

If you have undertaken other study such as national certificate, HNC or HND courses you may have undertaken unitsthat have demonstrated this level of study. You can check this by using MYSQA website which you can access at <a href="https://example.com/homes/

One you have registered you should click on 'my results'



Then tick 'show SCQF' box:



Scroll down to 'core skill' Communication and Numeracy and click on the + to open up the box to show your evidenced skills:



If you have **Communication: Oral Communication** and **Communication: Written Communication** at **Intermediate 2** or above, then you have the **literacy** requirements for entry to the programme.

If you have **Numeracy: Using Graphical Information**, and **Numeracy: Using Number** at **Intermediate 2** or above, thenyou have the **numeracy** requirements for entry to the programme.
